Literacy

Exploring different traditional tales

(3 little pigs, Goldilocks, Little Red Riding Hood, The Gingerbread man, Jack and the Beanstalk).

To spell words using phonic knowledge.

Writing dictated captions and sentences.

Creating wanted posters.

Writing about recent events that have occurred in class (crime scene).



Communication and Language

Can remember key information from recently introduced stories.



To sequence stories knowing that it has a beginning, middle and end.

Introduction to key vocabulary: author, illustrator, characters and settings.

Participate in small group work, offering their own ideas and explanations.

Exploring the changes to the weather.

Taking care of plants in the garden.

Exploring different materials: straw, hay and brick.

Is aware of similarities and differences between themselves and their peers.

Identifying 1 more & 1 less.

Exploring odd and even numbers.

Introducing numbers 16-20.

Days of the week and months of the year.

Writing recognisable letters using a cursive style of handwriting.

Independent in getting dressed and undressed for PE.

Team games in PE.

Develop throwing and catching ability.

Creating pictures representing insects and bugs.
