in a range of events. The final event being the straight sprint for house point glory. Well done to everyone who took part and thank you to all the parents who attended and cheered the children on.

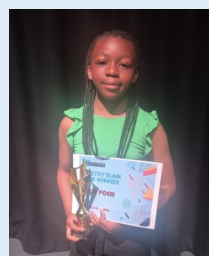


Democracy in Action

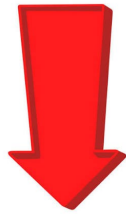
