



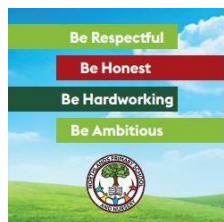

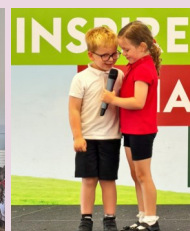

Out of School Success

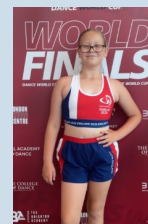
For the final time this academic year we are celebrating those children who are demonstrating our school values outside of school. Well done to:
