Place Value - Read, write, order, compare and round numbers up to 10,000 and up to 2dp, divide 1/2 digits by 10/100, Estimate on a number line, 1,10,100 and 1000 more or less, count in multiples of 6,7,9,25 and 100.

Four Operations - add and subtract 4 digits and up to 1dp, use the inverse, factor pairs, multiply and divide 3 by 1 digit, solve problems with the four operations

Animals including humans - carnivores, omnivores, herbivores, structure and function of animal teeth, teeth decay, digestive system, food chains, predators and prey
