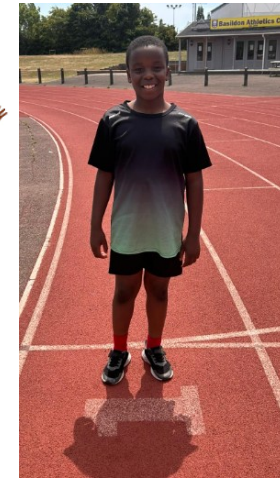


Sycamore Class Assembly
