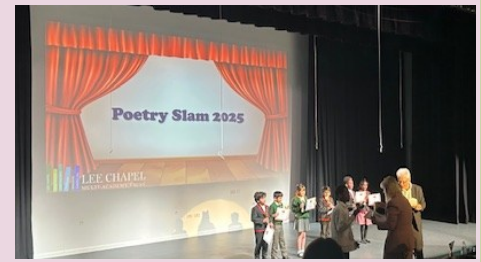
Celebration Assemblies

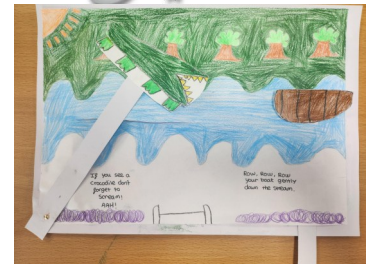
