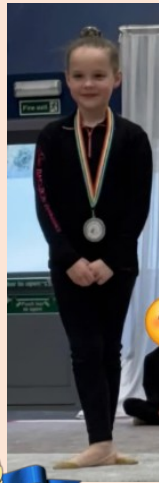
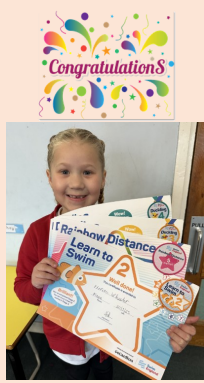

## Mother's Day SALE

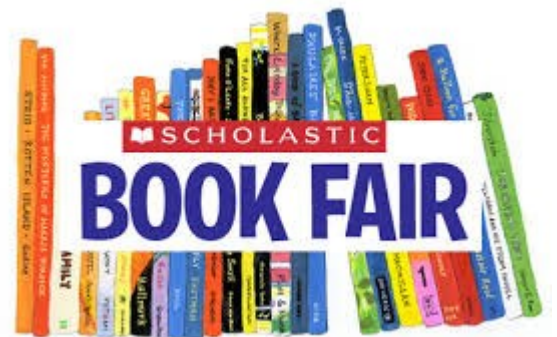
