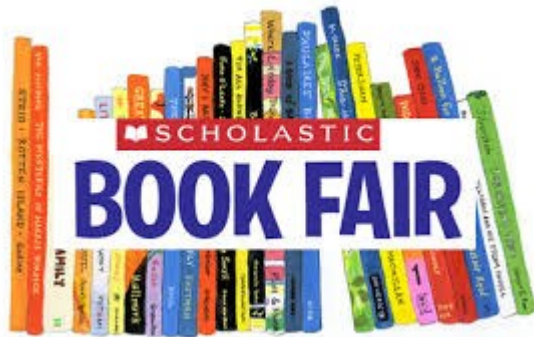


The winning streak continues.....
