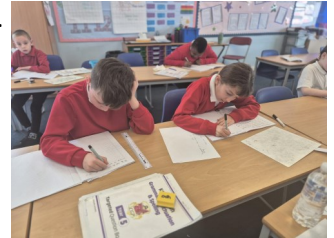
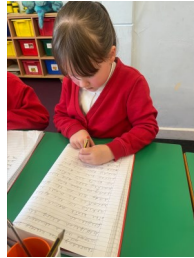
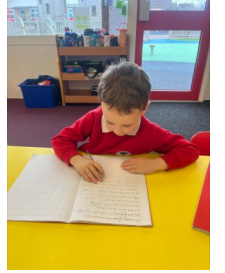
### Year 3 & 4 Football Tournament

Well done to Poppy who took part in a judo competition and came 2nd!



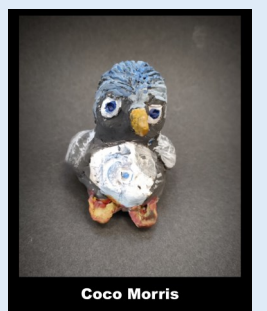
Great job to Daniel who participated in a Judo competition and achieved second place.

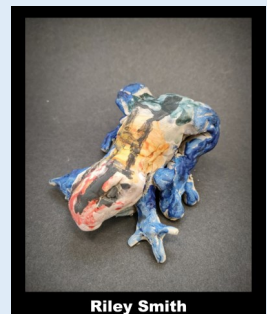

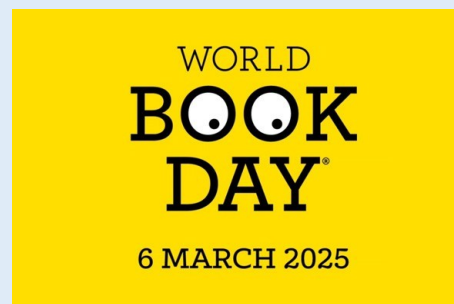


**Year 5 production tickets**
