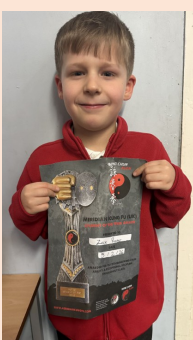
**Year 1 and The History of Toys-** The Year One children had an amazing day this week learning about the History of Toys! They became toy makers and made their very own
