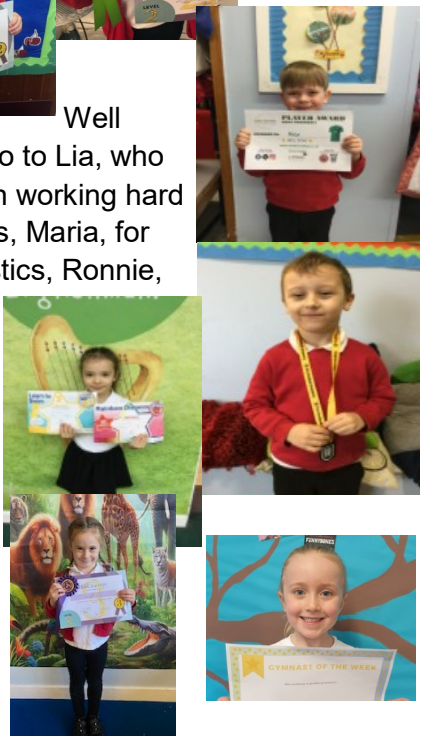
Out of School Success- We always love to hear how hardworking, ambitious, respectful and honest our pupils are being outside of school. This week we'll do to:
