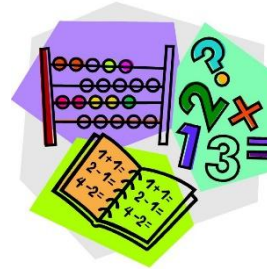
Year One	Topic: Transport
