Initial hook: Marvelous Monarchy Day	Final Activity: Double Page Spread

English

The Breadwinner - dialogue scenes and persuasive letters.

Amari and the night Brothers - setting descriptions, balanced arguments, narratives and non-chronological reports.

Maths

Geometry - identifying, comparing and ordering angles, comparing and classifying quadrilaterals and triangles and finding lines of symmetry.

Statistics - using sorting diagrams to compare and classify, interpreting and presenting discrete and continuous data.

Measurement - time, money, temperature, perimeter and area and converting between different units of measurement (e.g. km to m or hour to min)

Electricity - How to use electrical appliances safely, the relationship between battery power and light output, the effects of open and closed switches, recognising electrical conductors.

Sound - Know that sounds are made by vibrations; know how sound travels through the ear; know that the volume of instruments changes with how much force is applied when playing/plucking.

We are Artists - researching artists and recreating repeating patterns.

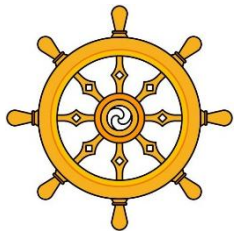
